



Year R Topic (5): A Pirate's Life For Me!

Hook: Sharing pirate themed representations

Learning Opportunities:

Drawing treasure maps of the outdoor area for pre-school for topic hook

Collecting and counting pirate underpants on a woodland trail treasure hunt

Ordering the o'clock times and days of the week with Tiddler

Doubling small world fish in the water tray with fishing nets and foam dice

Learning the Five Oceans and Seven Continents songs

Designing our own story maps for 'We're Going on a Pirate Hunt'

Measuring and comparing the volume of the five world oceans

Counting pirate treasure and sharing into equal groups

Pirate themed creative representation

Pirate instructions: How to make a pirate flag/hat/play battleships

Exploring the doubling and halving pirate treasure chest

Investigating sinking and floating in the water tray

Buying fruit using real-life money context

Creating news reports based on the story of 'The Pirate Cruncher'

Writing letters to pre-school inviting them to our topic end goal

Designing pirate themed game using physical equipment

Singing sea shanties and pirate songs

Foundation Friday (Captain Flinn and the Pirate Dinosaurs) with pre-school:

Retelling and sequencing the story using small world figures, puppets and props

Creating a representation of the Acorn pirate ship using materials and investigating

floating and sinking in the water tray

Mathematical treasure hunt - counting and sorting pirate coins

Classification of dinosaurs based on key characteristics and behaviours

Representation of pirate dinosaurs using own ideas and materials

Retelling the story using dance movements, songs and musical instruments
