## Learning Opportunities

### Hook: Planting seeds

**Communication and Language:** Story times, describing events in detail and asking questions to find out more.

**Personal and Social Development:** Being independent, building our resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge and began learning to look after ourselves with exercise and healthy eating.

**Physical Development:** In PE we focused on Athletics and ball skills. Throughout the term we focused on handwriting skills and letter formation.

**Literacy:** We looked at a range of stories, non-fiction books and poems which inspired our writing which included posters, letters, cards and instructions.

**Maths:** In class each morning we continued our purposeful daily maths looking at our lunch options and number of children in school. We also used our snack time to introduce our snack shack and bought our fruit each day practising digit recognition and 1:1 counting. We continued using Numberblocks which the children love!

**Understanding of the World:** We have been learning how to look after plants and the environment, we began to explore different countries around the world talking about places we would like to visit and shared photographs of ourselves and our families in the past.

**Expressive Art and Design:** We researched the artist Van Gogh, and talked about his different paintings. We used Van Gogh as inspiration for our own artwork of flowers refining our skills of painting.

**End Goal:** We invited year 4 to read our non-fiction books we authored and showed them the plants we grew and talked about how we cared for them.
