

# Terrific Transport Learning Opportunities



## Hook: Visit from Car and Campervan

**Communication and Language:** Story times, describing events in detail and asking questions.

**Personal and Social Development:** Showing empathy, building our resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge and learning to look after ourselves such as road safety and bedtime routines.

**Physical Development:** In PE we focused on gymnastics. Throughout the term we focused on handwriting skills and letter formation.

**Literacy:** We looked at a range of stories, non-fiction books and poems which inspired our writing which included posters, letters, cards and instructions.

**Maths:** In class each morning we continued our purposeful daily maths looking at our lunch options and number of children in school. We also used our snack time to introduce our snack shack and brought our fruit each day practising digit recognition and 1:1 counting. We also introduced an additional daily maths using Numberblocks as inspiration looking at part, part, whole and odds and even.

**Understanding of the World:** We have been talking about different ways people celebrate, history of transport, looking after our environment and protecting wildlife.

**Expressive Art and Design:** We listened to different music and shared how this made us feel, we practised the skill of drawing and introduced the skill of pastels.

**End Goal:** We worked in our fruit groups to plan and organise an Easter egg hunt for another fruit group. We all completed the Easter egg hunt and use the prizes to create rice crispy cakes (a prize we selected in our fruit groups).
