Hook: Starting School

Communication and Language: Story times, nursery rhymes, listening games and lots of talking.

Personal and Social Development: Practising independence, making friendships, talking about our feelings and our friend's, learning and following new rules.

Physical Development: Getting changed for PE, using bikes and trikes, messy play and using the hammer to decorate a pumpkin with golf tees.
